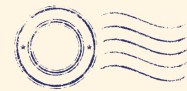

DAY 1

Toronto to Banff

Depart Toronto for Calgary and transfer to Banff for a 1-night stay. Welcome dinner in Banff. **D**

DAY 2

Banff to Kamloops

Transfer to train station after checking out of hotel to board Rocky Mountaineer. You'll have breakfast on the train and spend the night in Kamloops. **BL**

DAY 3

Kamloops to Vancouver

Enjoy the westbound journey to Vancouver on the Rocky Mountaineer. After disembarking, transfer to your hotel to spend the night. **BL**

DAY 4

Vancouver

Sightsee on a full day tour of Vancouver including Stanley Park, English Bay, Canada Place, Gastown, and more. **B**

DAY 5

Vancouver

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before transferring to the cruise terminal to board Holland America Line's *Koningsdam*[®] for your 7-day Alaska cruise. **BLD**

DAY 6

Scenic Cruising the Inside Passage

Glacier Bay, Alaska

Ketchikan, Alaska
