DAY 1: TORONTO TO VICTORIA

Fly from Toronto to Victoria. Explore Butchart Gardens before checking in at your hotel. Enjoy a welcome dinner with the group. **D**

DAY 2: VICTORIA TO NANAIMO

Travel to Nanaimo with your choice of a visit to the totem poles in Duncan or opt into the Malahat SkyWalk. Evening at leisure. **B**

DAY 3: NANAIMO

Spend the day discovering Nanaimo's waterfront and culinary scene or opt for a whalewatching eco-tour to Tofino. Or even rent a car for the day and explore the island. **B**

DAY 4: NANAIMO TO VANCOUVER

Take a scenic ferry to Horseshoe Bay and enjoy a panoramic tour of Vancouver's North Shore and downtown highlights. Evening at leisure. **B**

DAY 5: ROCKY MOUNTAINEER – VANCOUVER TO KAMLOOPS

Board Rocky Mountaineer and travel through the Fraser Valley and along the Thompson River. Overnight in Kamloops. **BL**

DAY 6: ROCKY MOUNTAINEER – KAMLOOPS TO BANFF

Continue through the Rockies, passing the Spiral Tunnels and Kicking Horse Canyon. Upon arrival in Banff, transfer to Canmore for an overnight stay. **BL**

Travel to Calgary for a guided city tour featuring the Calgary Tower, Stampede Grounds and Olympic sites. Evening at leisure. **B**

DAY 9: CALGARY

Explore at your own pace or book an optional excursion, such as the Drumheller Badlands Tour or a visit to the Yamnuska Wolfdog Sanctuary. Farewell dinner. **BD**

DAY 10: CALGARY TO TORONTO

Enjoy breakfast before transferring to the airport for your return flight home. **B**
